ALLOCATION OF THE EU BUDGET 2007

September 2008

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Legenda:

This document is based on the European Commission DG Budget documents "EU budget 2007 financial report" and "Detailed data 2000-2007". The data covers the countries that were Member States at the time.

Summary **table 1** in **Part 1** presents the allocation of EU Budget expenditure by Member State in 1992 - 2007. In 2007 the largest shares of expenditure (more than 10% of total) were allocated to France (13%), Spain (12%), Germany (12%) and Italy (11%). Whereas these four countries together accounted for 50,9% in 2006, they accounted for 47,9% in 2007. The smallest shares (below 1%) were allocated to Bulgaria (0,6%), Latvia (0,6%), Slovenia (0,4%), Estonia (0,4%), Cyprus (0,1%) and Malta (0,1%).

Member States' total own resources payments to the EU budget are shown in **table 2**. The largest total own resources payers (more than 10% of total) to the EU budget in 2007 were Germany (20%), France (15%), Italy (13%) and the United Kingdom (12%). The smallest shares (below 1%) were paid by Hungary (0,8%), Slovakia (0,5%), Slovenia (0,3%), Bulgaria (0,3%), Luxembourg (0,3%), Lithuania (0,2%), Latvia (0,2%), Cyprus (0,2%) and Malta (0,1%).

Table 3 and **Chart 1** show the allocation of expenditure by Member State and by Financial Framework heading in 2007, in millions of Euro.

Charts 2 - 7 show how the expenditure in the Financial perspective headings was shared out among the Member States in 2007, as a percentage of total expenditure in that heading. The recipients of the largest shares (more than 10% of the total for the heading concerned) were:

- Competitiveness: Germany (16%), France (13%), Belgium (12%) United Kingdom (12%) and Italy (12%);
- Cohesion: Spain (15%), Greece (12%), Italy (12%), Germany (12%) and Poland (11%);
- Natural Resources: France (19%), Spain (13%), Germany (13%) and Italy (11%);
- Citizenship, freedom, security and justice: Germany (24%);
- EU as a global player and Compensation: Romania (58%), Bulgaria (22%) and Poland (12%);
- Administrative expenditure: Belgium (60%) and Luxembourg (18%).

Member States' operating budgetary balances (**table 4** and **chart 8**) reveal the difference between the Member States' contributions and the amounts of allocated expenditure received in 1998 - 2007. Operating budgetary balances are expressed in absolute terms and relative to GNI. In 2007 the largest EU net contributors (more than 1 billion EUR) in absolute terms were Germany (7,4 billions EUR), the United Kingdom (4,2 billions EUR), France (3 billions EUR), the Netherlands (2,9 billions EUR) and Italy (2,0 billions EUR). The largest net recipients (more than 1 billion EUR) were Greece (5,4 billions EUR), Poland (5,1 billions EUR), Spain (3,6 billions EUR), Portugal (2,5 billions EUR) and Hungary (1,6 billions EUR). As a per cent of GNI the largest contributors (more than 0,3%) were the Netherlands (0,50%) and Luxembourg (0,40%), and the largest recipients (more than 2%) were Lithuania (2,95%), Latvia (2,55%) and Greece (2,43%).

In **chart 8** operating budgetary balances in EU-25 in 1998, 2001, 2004 and 2007 are compared. Most of the Member States remained either net recipients or net contributors throughout the period. Only exception were Denmark and Cyprus, which went from being net recipients to being net contributors, and the United Kingdom, which was a net recipient in 2001 but a net contributor for the rest of the period. Positive balances have decreased sharply in Greece, Ireland and Portugal since 1998. Over the period 2004-2007 they also decreased in Malta and Slovenia but increased in the Czech Republic, Spain, Lithuania, Latvia, Hungary, Poland and Slovakia.

Table 5 and **charts 9 - 11** present national contributions per capita and as a per cent of GDP in 2007. Contributions as % of GDP were the highest (more than 1%) in Greece (1,22%) and the lowest (less than 0,75%) in Ireland and Austria (0,74%) and the United Kingdom (0,53%).

Contributions to the EU budget per capita per day were the highest (more than 1 EUR) in Luxembourg (1,59 EUR) and the lowest (less than 20 cents) in Bulgaria (0,08 EUR), Romania (0,12 EUR), Poland and Lithuania (0,18 EUR).

Chart 12 shows Member States' contributions and allocated expenditure as a per cent of the whole EU budget.

The tables in the **Part 2** show the allocated EU budget expenditure for each Member State according to Agenda 2000 and the Multiannual Financial Framework. The graphs show how the amount of allocated expenditure changed from 2000 compared to 2006 (2004 to 2006 for EU-10). Pie charts show the structure of allocated expenditure in 2007.

Chart 1. Allocation of expenditure by Financial Perspective heading to Member States in 2007, (million EUR)

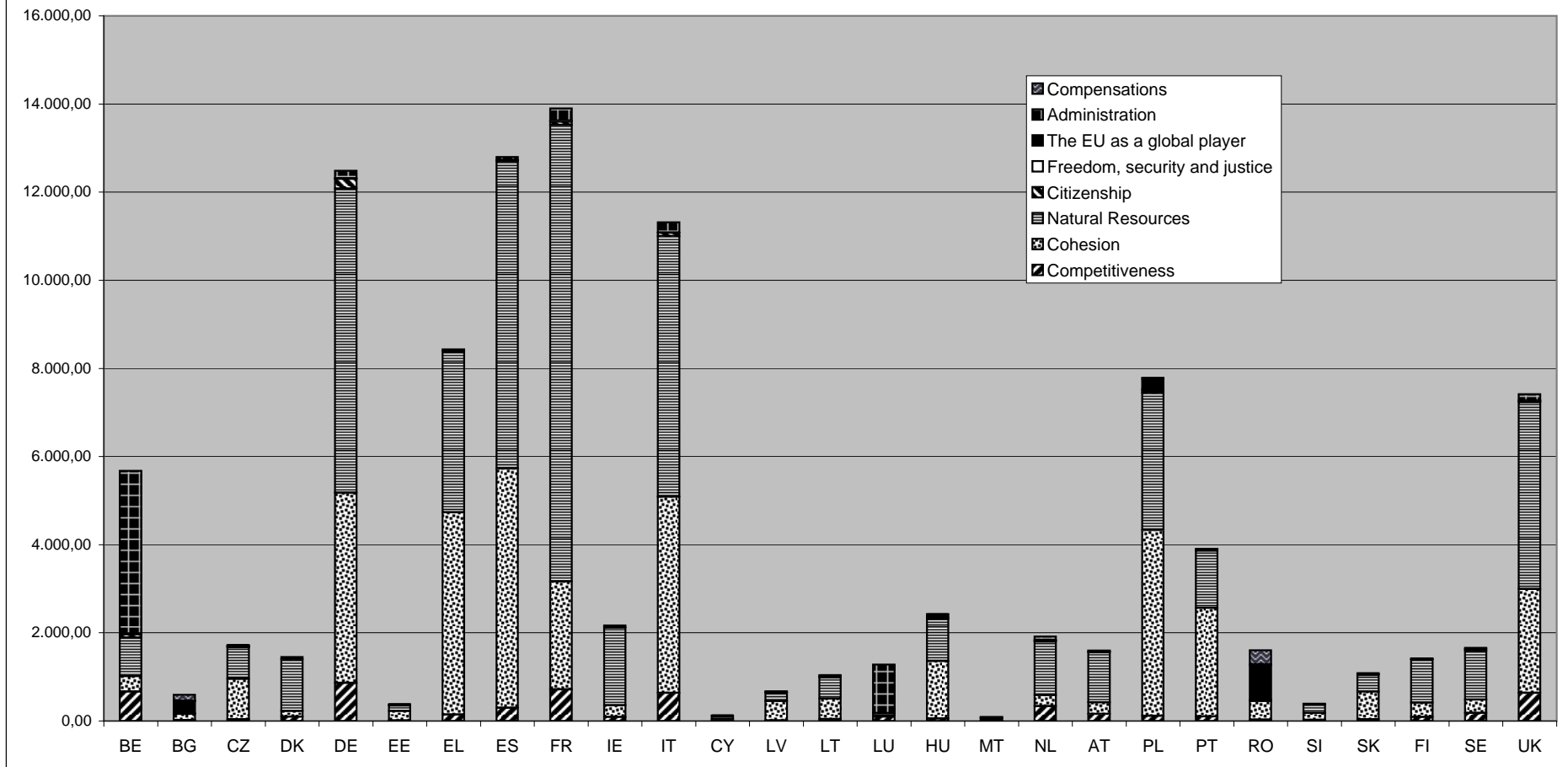
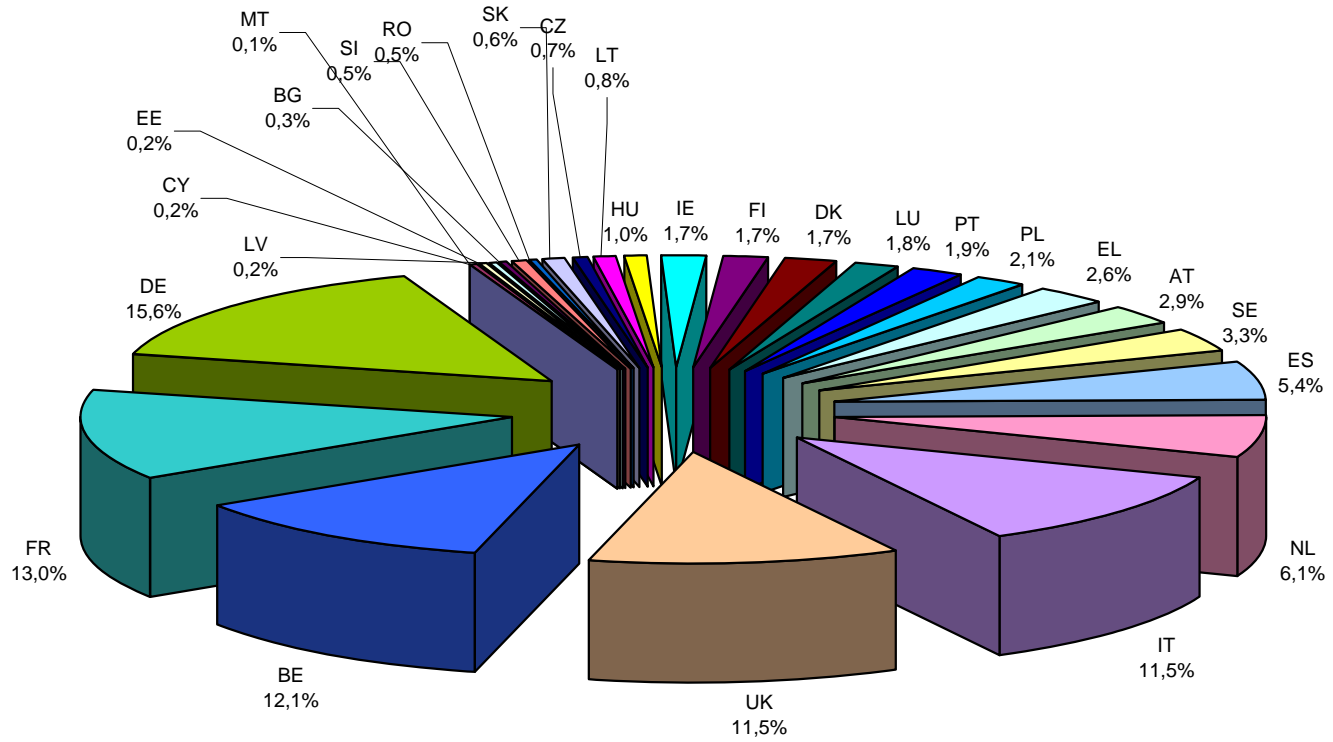


Chart 2. EU Competitiveness expenditure by Member State in 2007 (% of total EU, ranked by size)

(% of total EU, ranked by size)**

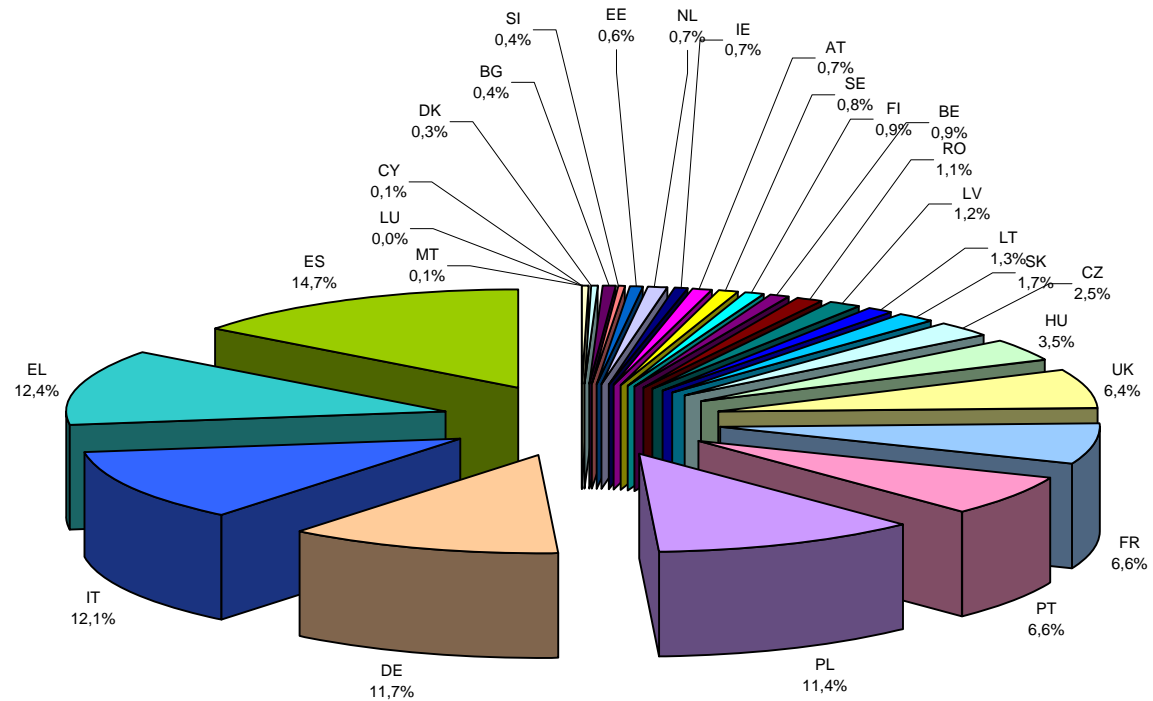
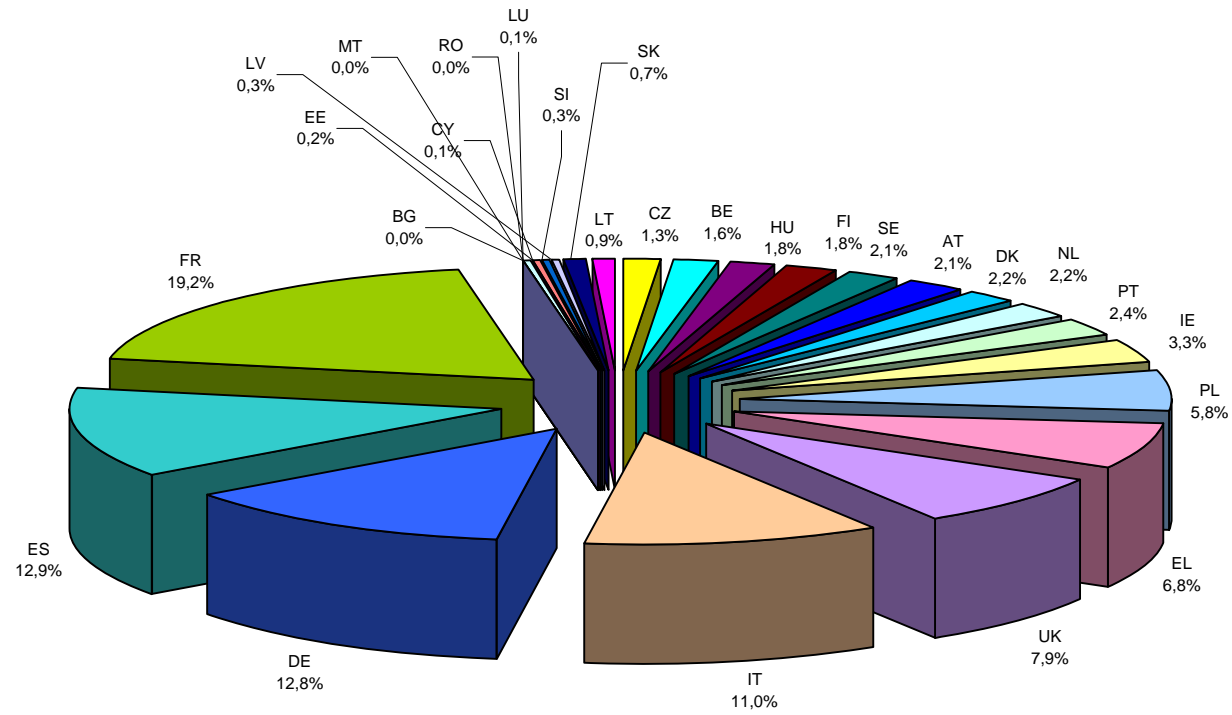


Chart 4. Natural Resources expenditure by Member State in 2007 (% of total EU, ranked by size)

(% of total EU, ranked by size)**

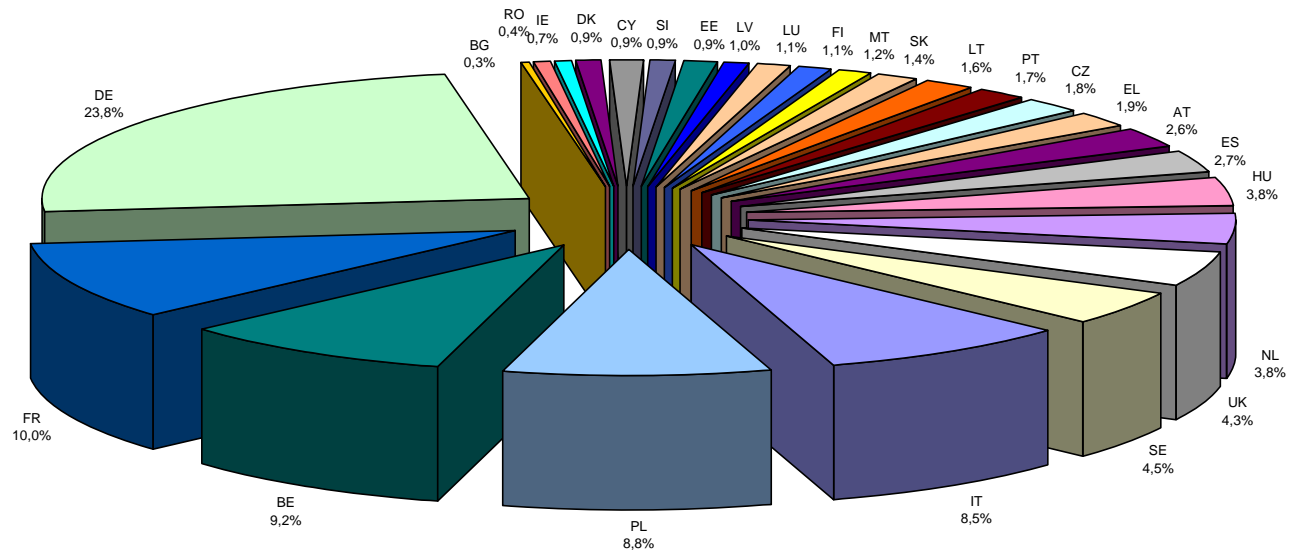
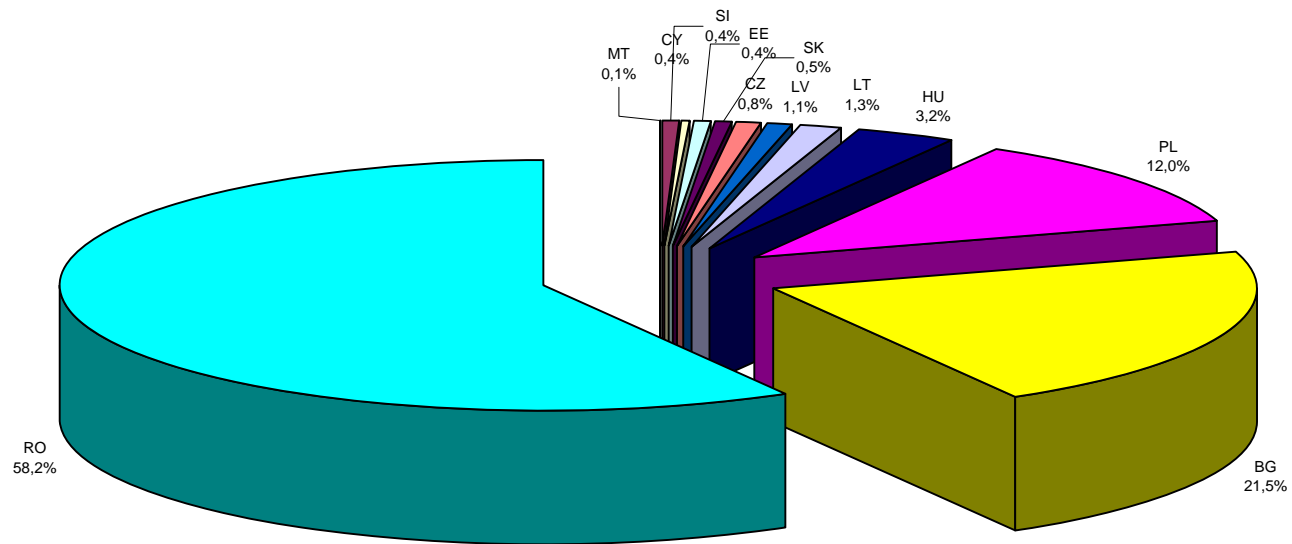


Chart 6. EU as a global player expenditure & Compensation by Member State in 2007

(% of total EU, ranked by size)**

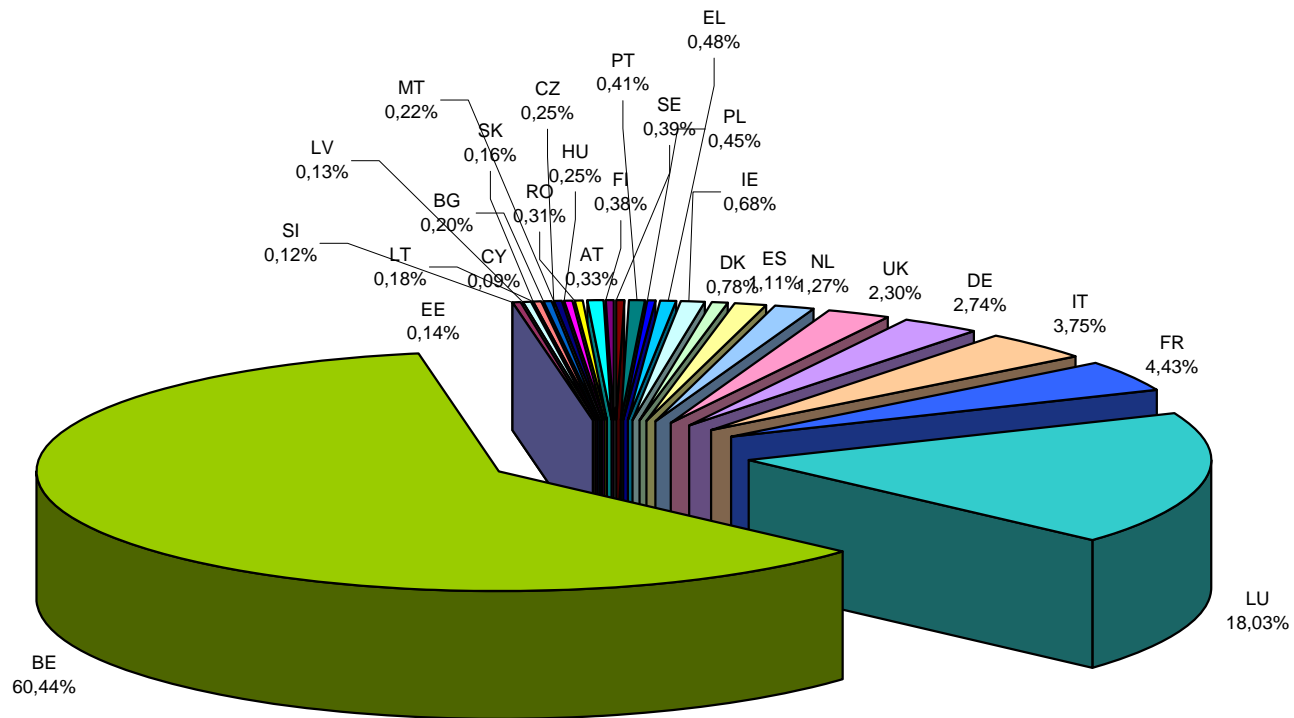

Chart 8. Operating budgetary balances by Member State EU27, 1998, 2001, 2004, 2007 (% GNI)

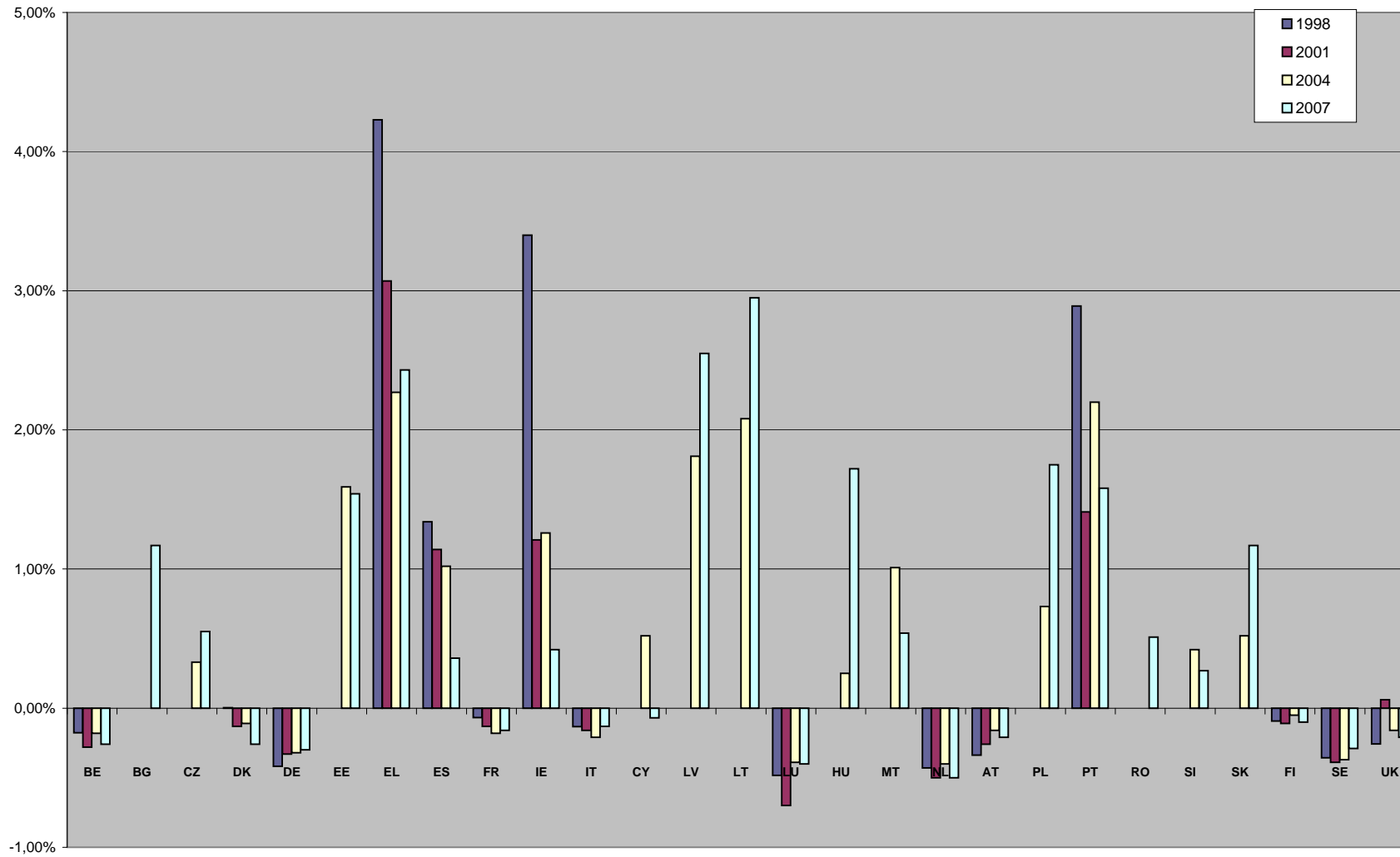

Chart 9. GDP per capita by Member State in 2007 (in EUR)

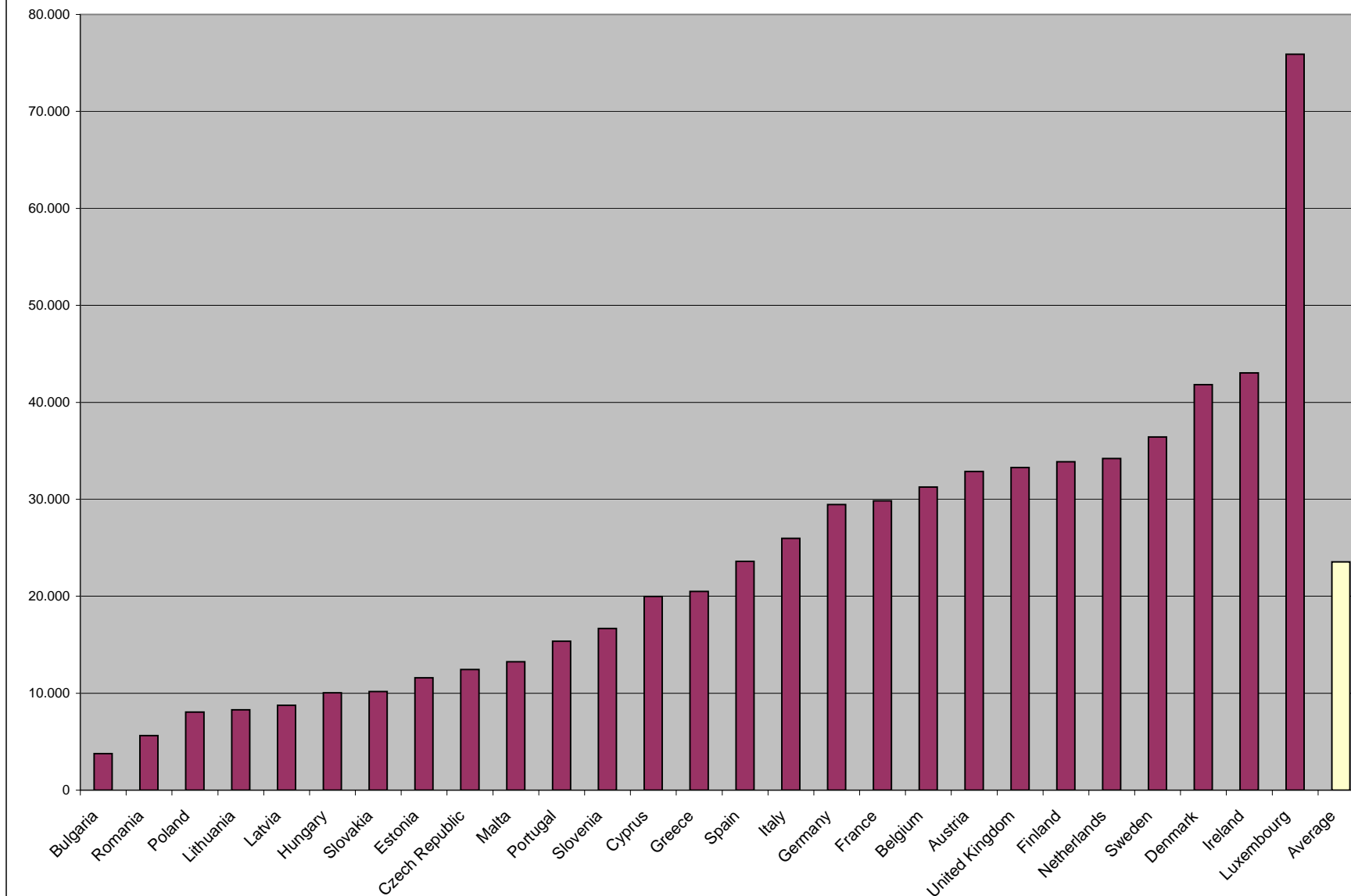


Chart 10. Contribution to EU budget per capita per day by Member State in 2007 (in EUR)

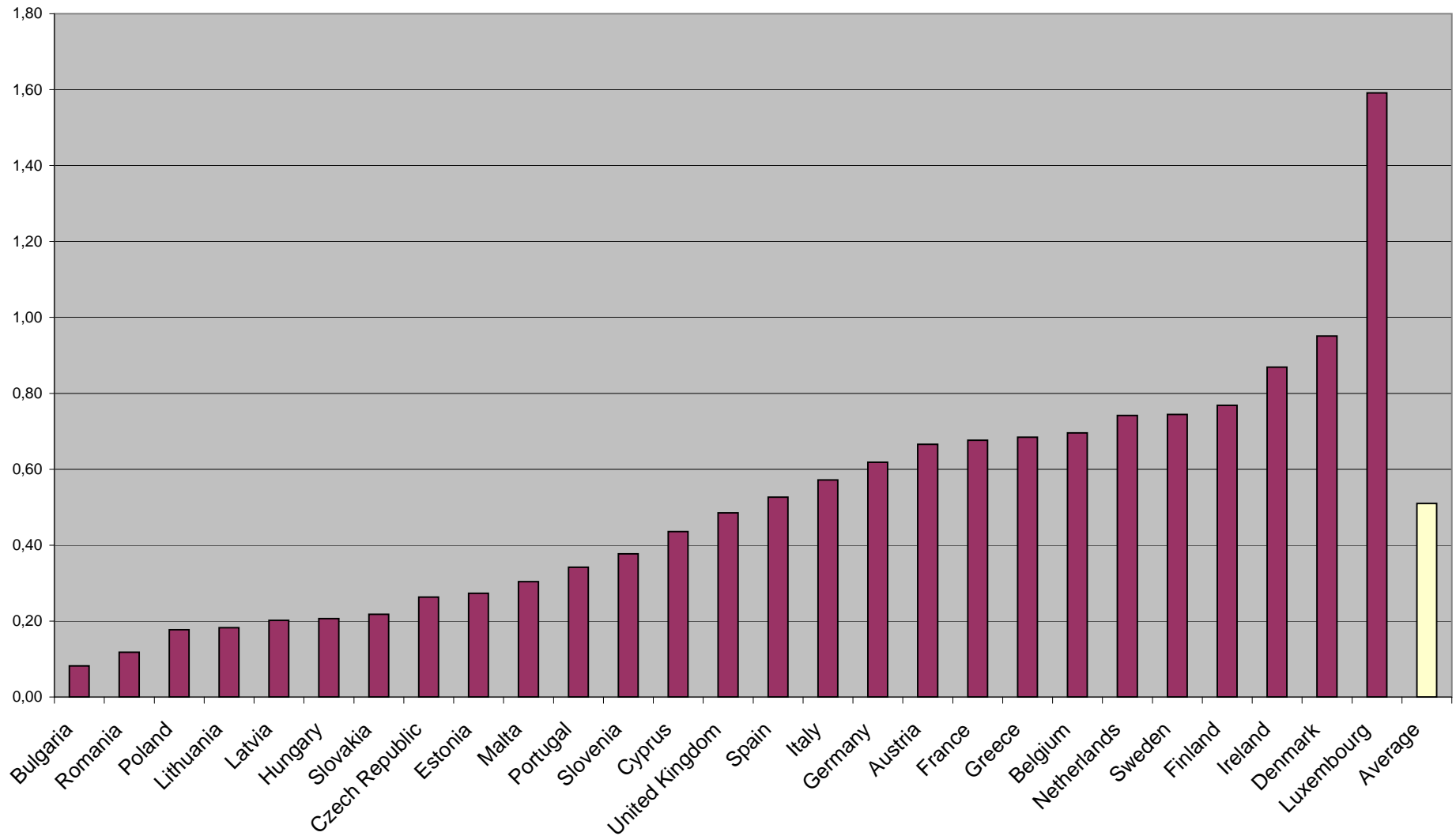


Chart 11. Contribution as % of GDP by Member State in 2007 (in EUR)

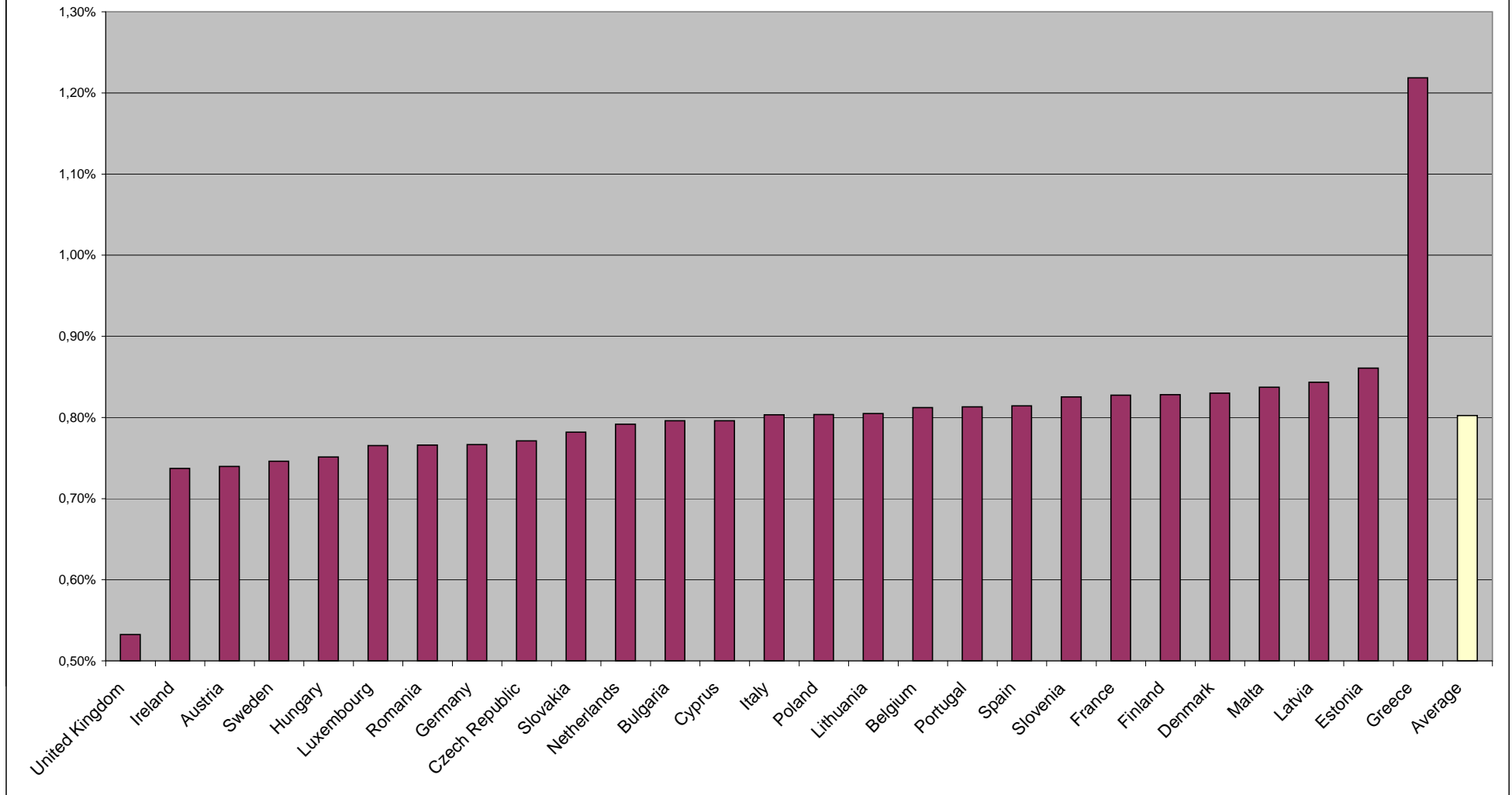


Chart 12. Share of contribution to EU budget and allocated expenditure by Member State in 2007

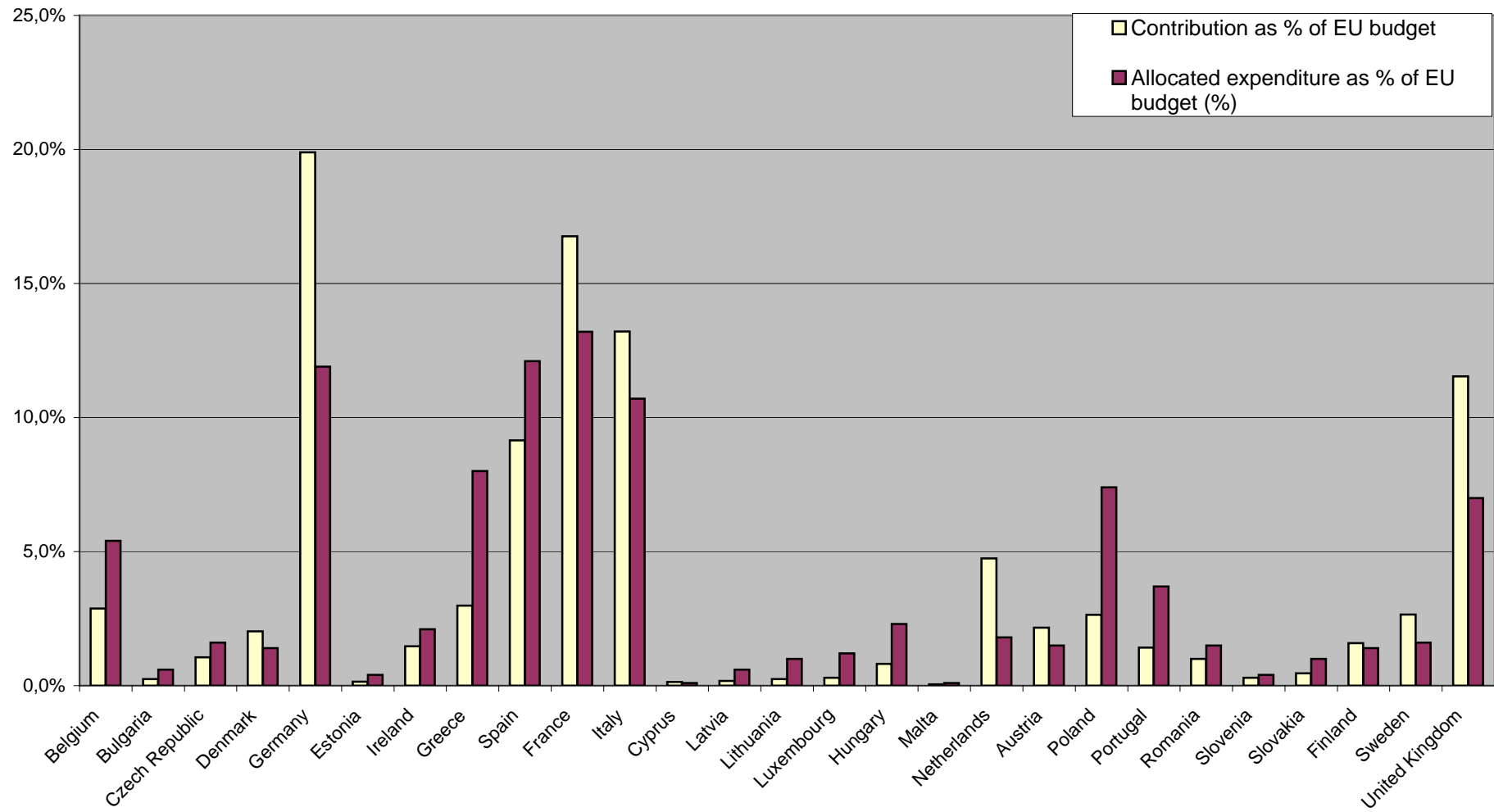

Allocation of EU expenditure 2007 to the CZECH REPUBLIC

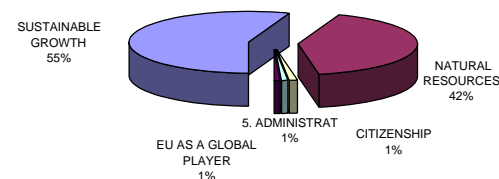
